Invalid Entries

Invalid entries will be returned to the address on the entry form. The following constitute an invalid entry:

- An entry which is missing any AKC required information.
- Entries not on Official AKC forms or on a photocopy of an AKC form without the current AKC agreement on the reverse side or attached to the entry form.
- Entries which are illegible or incomplete or received with insufficient fees.
- Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, email, telephone, FAX, entries cannot be accepted.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

CONFIRMATIONS

- Confirmations will be sent via US mail **ONLY** if an exhibitor does not have an active e-mail address or upon specific request.
- A Preliminary Confirmation will be sent to the e-mail address on the AKC entry form after your entry has been processed. Please review the information in the confirmation for input errors and notify the Trial Secretary of any corrections.
- Final confirmations of entry and judging schedule will be sent to the e-mail address on the AKC entry form after the closing date.

NOTE: If the exhibitor has not received the Final confirmation within five days of the trial, please contact the Trial Secretary.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees will be made.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. No classes will be held up by a late exhibitor.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. No dogs may be left tied to trees, cars, fences, etc.

Dogs under 4 months of age are not allowed at this trial.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

RIBBONS AND AWARDS

Rosettes will be awarded to the first through fourth place dog in each jump height division in each class. Flat Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score.

AGCH/MACH/PACH/PAX Rosettes and a MACH/PACH/PAX bar will be given to exhibitors earning a MACH, PACH or PAX title at this trial. New title ribbons will be given to dogs earning a new title.

All ribbons and prizes must be claimed the day of the Trial; none will be mailed.

MOVE UPS

Move ups must be sent in writing (E-mail is acceptable and preferred) to the Trial Secretary for the Oct 19th trial no later than Monday, Oct 15th at 6pm.

Day to Day move ups will be accepted but must be written in the move up book (on ribbon table) no later than 15 minutes after the last run is judged for each class.

CLASSES OFFERED

Friday : Excellent/Masters STD and JWW, All FAST and T2B will be offered. All levels of STD and JWW, regular and preferred, and all levels of FAST and T2B will be offered on Saturday and Sunday.

Please consult AKC rules and regulations pertaining to Agility Trials for complete description and eligibility for entry in these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class/division.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Owners/Agents are responsible for entering the proper height divisions.

If your dog needs to be measured, check the box at the top of the entry form so that your dog is placed on the Measuring List. A VMO will be present.

It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

LOW to HIGH (4, 8, 12, 16, 20, 24, 24C) on **Saturday**

SATURDAY /SUNDAY

EX/MAS JWW; T2B; EX/MAS STD; COMBINED FAST; OPN STD; NOV STD; OPN JWW; NOV JWW

OBSTACLES

All obstacles and equipment used at this trial meet the requirements for agility trials.

All exhibitors should obtain a copy of the Regulations for Agility Trials by downloading them from the American Kennel Club website at <http://www.akc.org/rules/>.

Additional Site Information

- » Setup on Thursday night from 4pm to 7pm.
- » Site opens by 7am each day.
- » **Crating space** will be available. The Trial site **requires tarps** under your crates. Park in rear of building for crating. Must use stairs to access doors. If pulling cart, park in front to unload.
- » Building is climate controlled but Crown is a large building hard to air condition. Please bring appropriate cooling supplies for you and your dog. Large fans will be provided by the club in crating area and ring.
- » **Flexi-Leads are not to be used in the building**
- » No Cleats allowed in the Building. Running shoes and turf shoes acceptable
- » Please do not take dogs into areas they are not allowed.
- » Pick up after your dog. Any exhibitor caught not cleaning up after their dog will be asked to leave the trial grounds. No refund will be given if this occurs.
- » **NO OUTSIDE FOOD OR DRINK.** A Café is available on the premises. Celebration cakes, worker snacks and dog treats are allowed.
- » BHAD and the Crown Sports Center will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

Refunds

Bitches in season will not be admitted to the trial. Any exhibitor with an entered bitch in season, on the trial date, will be refunded the entry fee, less \$3 per run (each day), upon written certification from a veterinarian. Notification must be in the hands of the trial secretary no later than the start time on the date of the trial.

Injuries – Dogs that cannot compete due to an injury will be given a partial refund minus **\$6.50** for the 1st run and **\$6** for each additional run (per day). A written vet letter must be given to the Trial Secretary no later than the start time on the date of the trial.

Jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No.box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
