CHECK IN and MEASURING

Please check in on the gate sheets located in a binder near the entrance of each ring. No armbands will be used. All dogs needing to be measured must be measured prior to running by the judge of record (or if a VMO is present, by the VMO). Measurements will take place, as necessary before each class. **A VMO WILL BE PRESENT.**

MOVE-UPS

Move-ups must be received by the Trial Secretary in writing (emailed preferred) by 6pm on Monday, April 29th, 2019. Be sure that I have acknowledged receipt of your move-up. **VERBAL MOVE UPS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED OR PROCESSED.**

Day to day move ups (Friday to Saturday or Saturday to Sunday) must be written in the MOVE UP BOOK located near the ribbons within 15 minutes of the last run of each class.

GENERAL

- The building is not climate controlled. Please bring appropriate clothing and dog paraphernalia to keep both of you warm/cool.
- Crating space will be available. The trial site has a dirt floor-please bring appropriate tarps.
- We will have a food vendor on site. Please check out the great food items.
- Please be considerate of other exhibitors and our workers. Do not let your dog urinate inside the building, on garbage cans, equipment, etc. Someone must handle these!!
- Please pick up after your dog and place in the designated bags placed conveniently around the outside of the building. PLEASE DO NOT PUT ANY DOG EXCREMENTS IN TRASH CANS WITHIN THE BUILDING!! Any exhibitor failing to clean up after their dog(s) may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.
- Flexi-leads **MUST** be kept at the **2' LOCKED** position when used **IN** and **NEAR** the building. All dogs **must be on leash** while on the show grounds, except when in an X-Pen, at the practice jump or running the course!
- RV parking will be available via reservation at the Trial site. Site with hookup is \$20/night and site without hookup is \$10/night. Please pay for the weekend when you arrive. Please pay the club treasurer, Denise Jester. **Absolutely NO RV ARRIVALS after 10:00pm any night.**
- Blue Heron Agility Association of Delaware and Heartland Equestrian Center will not be responsible for any item(s) damaged or left at the show site. If you lost something at a previous trial please look in our lost and found box.

Directions to Vet on Call (from Trial Site)

- Start out going SOUTH on Robbins Rd, toward Midstate RD/DE 12
- Turn RIGHT onto DE 12
- Turn RIGHT onto Canterbury RD, DE 15
- Turn SLIGHT RIGHT onto South Dupont HWY NORTH /US 13 ; 15 North
- Continue to follow South Dupont HWY North US 13
- Turn RIGHT onto WEST Lebanon RD/DE 10 East
- End at 1482 East Lebanon Rd., Dover, DE

Directions to Trial Site

From the North via Route 113S

Take RT 113S/RT 1 South to Frederica. Turn RT onto Rt12.
Follow RT 12 thru Frederica. RT 12 will turn right into Frederica
Onto E. Front St. Follow Rt 12 approx. 2.7 miles. Turn right onto
Robbins Rd. The site is on the right.

From the South via Route 113N

Take Rt 113N to Frederica. Turn RT at Exit 83 and follow
towards Frederica, Right to remain on Frederica Rd. Turn left
on E Front St (Rt12 W) and follow for 2.7 miles. Turn right
on Robbins Rd. The site is on the right.

From the South via Route 13N

Take RT 13N to Felton. Turn Right onto Midstate (RT12)
Go Approximately 3 miles. Turn Left onto Robbins Rd.
The site is on the right.

From the West (Bay Bridge)

Take RT 50/301East. Merge onto US 50 East. Turn left
onto 404. Go North on MD 313. Turn right onto MD 317
MD 317 changes to DE 14 in Delaware. Follow DE 14
through Harrington to RT 13. Turn left onto Rt 13.
Follow direction from the South via RT 13N.
