## Wait List for Withdrawn Entries after Closing

BHAD is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing on July 3, 2024. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to the trial closing date. Any entries withdrawn that are received by July 3, 2024 @ 6pm will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by Sunday, July 7, 2024 @ noon will receive a full refund.

## Entry Information

- PLEASE INCLUDE JUMP HEIGHT IF YOUR CLASS REQUIRES IT.  
All entries must indicate class "A" or "B"
- If entering for RAE/RACH, please check the box on the entry form. Dogs entered in this class will be entered in both Excellent B/Advanced B (RAE) or Excellent B/Advanced B/Master (RACH)
- Be sure to include the correct fees. Overpayments less than \$10 will not be refunded.
- All entries must be submitted on official AKC rally entry forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopies of front and back will be accepted only if legible and official AKC size.
- Entries will not be accepted without signature, back of entry form with agreement, and fees, nor will email, telephone or FAX entries be accepted.
- Owners are responsible for ensuring that entry forms are completed IN FULL. Entries submitted without ALL information will be returned as invalid  
\*\*\*PLEASE WRITE EMAIL ADDRESS LEGIBLY!!\*\*\*.
- Overnight service **MUST** check **AND** sign the **"NO SIGNATURE REQUIRED"** waiver box, as the Trial Secretary will not be present to sign for your entries.
- Limit 10 entries per envelope.

## Invalid Entries

Invalid entries will be returned to the address on the entry form. The following constitute an invalid entry:

- An entry which is missing any AKC required information.
- Entries not on Official AKC forms or on a photocopy of an AKC form without the current AKC agreement on the reverse side or attached to the entry form.
- Entries which are illegible or incomplete or received with insufficient fees.
- Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, email, telephone, FAX, entries cannot be accepted.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. A \$30.00 service fee will be added for all returned checks.

• **PLEASE CHECK YOUR ENTRIES CAREFULLY!**

**CONFIRMATIONS**

- Confirmations will be sent via US mail ONLY if an exhibitor does not have an active e-mail address or upon specific request.
- A Preliminary Confirmation will be sent to the e-mail address on the AKC entry form after your entry has been processed. Please review the information in the confirmation for input errors and notify the Trial Secretary of any corrections.
- Final confirmations of entry and judging schedule will be sent to the e-mail address on the AKC entry form after the closing date.

**NOTE: If the exhibitor has not received the Final confirmation within five days of the trial, please contact the Trial Secretary.**

## Notice to Exhibitors

- All Judging will be Indoors.
- Parking: Exhibitors may park all the way around the building. There is one business open on Thursday and Friday and one open on Sunday. Their parking spaces will be marked as reserved.
- Food will not be available onsite. Plan to bring your own lunch, water, drinks, ice, etc
- While the building is air conditioned and some fans are available, it can get warm. Please bring your own battery-operated fans for you and your dogs.
- Transfers will be permitted in accordance with Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 15. The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.
- Dogs will be arranged in jump height order. Tall to Small on Thursday and Saturday. Small to Tall on Friday.
- The rally ring is 40 x 50 feet.
- A wait-list will be established in order to fill openings created by entries that are withdrawn prior to the event closing date.
- The judge is not required to wait for a dog. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to have the dog at ringside when required and without being called.
- Limited crating may be available inside. Working out of your car may be the best option based on weather. Absolutely no unentered dogs allowed in the building.
- All dogs must be held on a leash, or confined to a crate except when being judged. No Flexi-Leads allowed in or near the building.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to

assure their dogs are free from internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The host club and its agents, employees, etc will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, injury or illness sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.

## Refunds

**Bitches in season will not be admitted in the trial.** Any exhibitor with an entered bitch in season, on the trial date, will be refunded the entry fee, less \$5 per run/per trial, upon written certification from a veterinarian. Notification must be in the hands of the trial secretary no later than the start time on the date of the trial.

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, A or B division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. - Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine Partners<sup>SM</sup> Program** may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC Rally trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC Number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box. Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

AGREEMENT

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.
