### CHECK IN and MEASURING

Please check in on the AGILITY GATE app (see info on last page) (CODE 0505) or with the gate steward. No armbands will be used. Measuring of dogs will be available by the VMO (Sandy Moody & Alex Davis) Measurements will take place, as necessary, throughout the day.

### MOVE-UPS

Move-ups must be received by the Trial Secretary in writing (emailed preferred at [shoretrialsecretary@outlook.com](mailto:shoretrialsecretary@outlook.com)) by 6pm on Monday, April 29, 2024. Be sure that I have acknowledged receipt of your move-up. **VERBAL MOVE UPS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED OR PROCESSED.**

**Day to day move ups (Friday to Saturday or Saturday to Sunday) must be written in the MOVE UP BOOK located near the ribbons within 15 minutes of the last run of each class.**

### GENERAL

- The barn is not climate controlled. Please bring appropriate clothing and dog paraphernalia to keep both of you warm/cool.
- Indoor crating space will be available in the stalls only. Space is limited and stalls must be shared.

- Flexi-leads **MUST** be kept at the 2' **LOCKED** position when used **NEAR** the building. Please NO flexileads in the building. All dogs **must be on leash** while on the show grounds, except when in an X-Pen, at the practice jump or running the course!
- RV parking will be available at the Trial site. Site with hookup is \$30/night and site without hookup is \$10/night. Please pay for the weekend when you arrive. Please pay in advance or at the Secretary's table. Checks made out to Heartland Equestrian. **Absolutely NO RV ARRIVALS after 10:00pm any night.**

- Turn RIGHT onto Canterbury RD, DE 15
- Turn SLIGHT RIGHT onto South Dupont HWY NORTH /US 13 ; 15 North
- Continue to follow South Dupont HWY North US 13
- Turn RIGHT onto WEST Lebanon RD/DE 10 East
- End at 1482 East Lebanon Rd., Dover, DE

### **Directions to Trial Site**

#### **From the North via Route 113S**

Take RT 113S/RT 1 South to Frederica. Turn RT onto Rt12. Follow RT 12 thru Frederica. RT 12 will turn right into Frederica onto E. Front St. Follow Rt 12 approx. 2.7 miles. Turn right onto Robbins Rd. The site is on the right.

#### **From the South via Route 113N**

Take Rt 113N to Frederica. Exit Right at Exit 83 and follow to RT 12. Turn Right to remain on Frederica Rd. Turn left on E Front St (Rt12 W). And follow for 2.7 miles. Turn right on Robbins Rd., The site is on the right.

#### **From the South via Route 13N**

Take RT 13N to Felton. Turn Right onto Midstate (RT12) Go Approximately 3 miles. Turn Left onto Robbins Rd. the site is on the right.

#### **From the West (Bay Bridge)**

Take RT 50/301East. Merge onto US 50 East. Turn left onto 404. Go North on MD 313. Turn right onto MD 317 MD 317 changes to DE 14 in Delaware. Follow DE 14 through Harrington to RT 13. Turn left onto Rt 13. Follow direction from the South via RT 13N.

# **AGILITY GATE INFORMATION**

## **AGILITY GATE: CODE 0505**

CHECK-IN - ONLY THE GATE-STEWARD CAN CHECK IN DOGS AT THE PHYSICAL GATE.

You can use the Agility Gate app for check-in instead of checking in at the physical gate. Remember you cannot check in before 6am day of.

To use the app, you will need to download the free app from the Appstore or Google Play. <https://agilitygate.com/>. Be sure to download the purple app.

You can also check your dog in with the gate-steward when you get ready to walk if you are not using the app.

From the Agility Gate app, you can:

- Check in your dog
- Mark your dog absent
- Mark Conflict
- Mark FEO
- Follow in real time where we are in the running order. On the app, you can see as the gate-steward marks each dog on the line the same way you normally see it on the gate sheets. The dog will have a line through the name once it steps on the line. You will see the whole gate-sheet(s) and see who is up; how many dogs until you can line up; how many dogs left to run in the height etc.
- View AND PRINT your course map (Click the icon on the right of the Class name when you open the gate-sheets to the class you are checking in for-the map will open. Click again to close) Maps are loaded by 6am (generally).
