All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to the trial closing date. Any entries withdrawn that are received by Sunday, June 9, 2024 @ noon will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by Sunday, June 9, 2024 @ noon will receive a full refund.

Entry Information

Invalid Entries

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR INTERNATIONAL SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES

(ISC):

This event is **NOT** a World Team Qualifying Event

The International Sweepstakes Class (ISC) is a non-regular class providing the dog and handler an opportunity to demonstrate their advanced training and handling skills on various International Style Standard and Jumpers with Weaves courses. The rules for this class are generally based on international rules. The variety in International Agility course designs is very diverse, so handlers should be prepared to meet the "Challenge of the Day" when competing in the ISC class. The total challenge level may be easier, more difficult, or simply different from what is currently allowed in Excellent / Master Class. Complete rules for the ISC are available from the AKC Website (<http://www.akc.org>)

ISC Standard & Jumpers courses are designed by Petr Pupik

Eligibility:

This class is open to dogs that are eligible to compete in AKC agility trials. **There is a Preferred Option for ISC**; dogs may enter at their preferred jump height. Regular and preferred height will be combined for determination of award placements.

Jump Heights:

Dogs may be entered in their regular jump heights or their preferred height. The FCI/ISC cutoffs for heights are as follows:

- Small (12" jump height) - for dogs measuring 13 $\frac{3}{4}$ " or less at the withers
- Medium (16" jump height) - for dogs measuring more than 13 $\frac{3}{4}$ " but less than 16 $\frac{7}{8}$ " at the withers
- Large (24" jump height) - for dogs measuring over 16 $\frac{7}{8}$ " at the withers

Who can enter: The ISC is open to any dogs eligible to run AKC courses.

Scoring: The ISC is combined overall scoring over the ISC Standard and Jumper runs each day - Scoring for each run will be faults plus time. PLEASE NOTE: The ISC scoring is separate from AKC qualification scoring. Dogs will still be scored per AKC rules to determine if the dog earns qualifications towards any AKC titles.

Course Faults will be as follows:

- R (runout, refusal) 5 faults
- F (Dropped bar, missed contact, failure to complete) 5 faults
- W (Wrong course) E
- 3 of Anything = E

Special Awards: The scores for each dog for each day will be added together and the lowest cumulative score will determine the winner in each height group, Regular and Preferred scored together.

To be eligible for the ISC Awards, the same dog must be entered in **both** ISC classes on each day..

In event of a tie, time will be used as a tie breaker. All ISC winners will be announced at the completion of the two runs, after the scores are tallied.

The 1st through 3rd place ISC winners in each height group will receive:

1st Place: Rosette, and Prize

2nd Place: Rosette, and Prize

3rd Place: Rosette and Prize

Flat ribbons will be awarded for each dog placing 1st-4th in each ISC run.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees will be made.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. No classes will be held up by a late exhibitor.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. No dogs may be left tied to trees, cars, fences, etc. Dogs under 4 months of age are not allowed at this trial.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

RIBBONS AND AWARDS FOR REGULAR CLASSES

Rosettes will be awarded to the first through fourth (non ISC) place dog in each jump height division in each class. Flat Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score.

MACH/PACH/PAX Rosettes and a MACH/PACH/PAX bar will be given to exhibitors earning a MACH, PACH or PAX title at this trial. New title ribbons will be given to dogs earning a new title. All ribbons and prizes must be claimed the day of the Trial; none will be mailed. PACH and PAX Titles earned on the same day: Please take either the PACH or PAX awards, not both.

MOVE UPS

Move ups must be sent in writing (E-mail is acceptable and preferred) to the Trial Secretary for the June 14th trial no later than Monday, June 10; 6pm.

Day to Day move ups will be accepted but must be written in the move up book (on ribbon table) no later than 15 minutes after the last run is judged for each class.

If your dog needs to be measured, check the box at the top of the entry form so that your dog is placed on the Measuring List. A VMO will be present all three days.

It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

Class Changes Effective January 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers with Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

- For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.
- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- **The exhibitor must declare FEO** in the ring prior to leading out to the scribe and the judge.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

- Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.
- FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

OBSTACLES

All obstacles and equipment used at this trial meet the requirements for agility trials.

All exhibitors should obtain a copy of the Regulations for Agility Trials by downloading them from the American Kennel Club website at <http://www.akc.org/rules/>.

Refunds

Bitches in season will not be admitted to the trial. Any exhibitor with an entered bitch in season, on the trial date, will be refunded the entry fee, less \$5 per run (each day), upon written certification from a veterinarian. Notification must be in the hands of the trial secretary no later than the start time on the date of the trial.

Injuries – Dogs that cannot compete due to an injury will be given a partial refund minus **\$7.00** for each run each day. A written vet letter must be given to the Trial Secretary no later than the start time on the date of the trial.

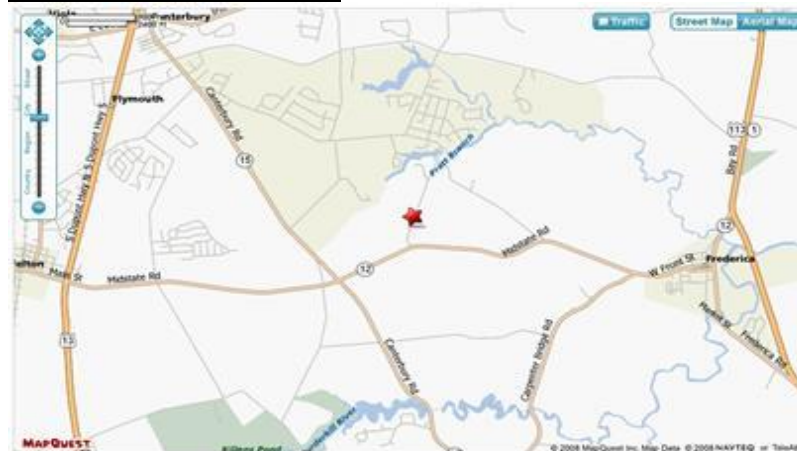

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners Program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.
